
NOTICE TO TENANTS AND GUESTS

FOR YOUR INFORMATION: To ensure that equal opportunity for maximum enjoyment is provided for all persons using the waters of Loon Lake for recreational purposes, the property owners of this community have formulated and mutually agreed to observe the following:

1. Water skiing and other water sports requiring the use of powered boats at high speeds, is limited to the period from one hour after sunrise to sunset.
2. All persons using the lake, especially those operating power boats and personal watercraft, will maintain a minimum of 200' from other persons and/or water craft, particularly fisherman, bathers, divers, canoes, rowboats and small powerboats to prevent any possibility of accidents or injuries occurring.

You are also reminded of the following New York State rules and regulations pertaining to the operation of boats and personal watercraft:

1. A boat towing a water skier or surfboard must have a person at least 10 years old aboard observing the person being towed in addition to the operator of the boat.
2. Boats, particularly motorboats, and water skiers shall not operate in a reckless or negligent manner.
3. Sailboats have the right of way over motorboats.
4. It is unlawful to use or dispose of any kind of soap, waste, litter, garbage or sewage into Loon Lake. It is harmful and unlawful to use soap or any other cleansing agent for bathing or washing items in the lake.
5. Individuals between the ages of 10 and 18 are required to complete an approved boating safety course in order to operate a boat or a personal watercraft
6. Personal watercraft operators may not operate in excess of 5 mph within 200' of a shore, a dock, float or anchored boat.
7. Personal watercraft may not operate within 500' of a marked swim area and only between the hours of 9am to 7pm.
8. Operating a personal watercraft in a reckless manor including wake jumping, playing "chicken" and weaving through traffic is also unlawful and subject to penalty.
